



The Novice spaghetti has 3 numbered lines which identify 9 of the 11 GL's to be crossed. And the other 2 are each crossed once only – worth remembering.

The first GL is 12, and you can see from the map that the second has to be 58. That is the first of the un-numbered ones, and as it is the only time it is crossed, you now know that the rest of the action in this section takes place north of GL58.

So you have to turn left at the brown road, and the next 8 GL's are 59, 12, 60, 12, 60, 59, 59 and 59 again. And you know that you have to approach TC62 from the NW because a SE approach would lead you into a dead end. So you also know that the final GL is the 13, and that (until that crossing) the route lies to the west of GL13.

All of that means that you have to take the white on the left so that you cross GL59 once only before GL12. The loop around Ballymagin accounts for the two 12's and the two 60's, and the three 59's together must take you back down the brown road, before TL on to the yellow to TC62.

The Experts don't get the location of that TC, nor any numbered spaghetti, but apart from that it is the same, including the direction of travel.

And the same logic quickly reveals the 12 and 58. And it then has to be 59 before 12 again.

GL60 is then the only "new" GL available to cross twice and, as for the Novices, the three 59's must take you down the brown and then on to the yellow for the final GL before the TC.
